**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ARTICLE VI REGARDING LOW SPEED VEHICLES**

---

- 1) Amend the rules and regulations by re-writing Article VI (b) as follows:
  - b) Except as otherwise provided below, only licensed vehicles with valid registration may be used on Island roads. Unlicensed motorized scooters, all-terrain vehicles, dune buggies and similar vehicles are prohibited on island beaches, roads and bike paths/sidewalks. Non-motorized vehicles such as scooters and bicycles are subject to the provisions of Article VI (h), (g) and (f) below.
- 2) Add a new Article VI (i) as follows:
  - i) Low speed vehicles whose top speed is greater than 20 miles per hour, but not greater than 25 miles per hour that are not currently licensed or registered by the North Carolina Division of Motor Vehicles may operate on Island roads, but not on any bike path or sidewalk, provided they meet the following conditions:
    - 1) They must have been previously licensed by the North Carolina division of Motor Vehicles, or advertised by the manufacturer as meeting the standards for licensing for a "low speed vehicle" by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
    - 2) They must have head lamps, tail lamps, stop lamps, turn signal lamps, reflex reflectors, a parking brake, a rear view mirror, a windshield and a seat belt for each passenger seat. All lamps must be in working order. Head lamps and tail lamps must be on between sunset and sunrise.
    - 3) The vehicle may only be operated by a person 16 years or older with a valid driver's license. Any driver must produce such license at the request of Figure Eight security or management personnel.
    - 4) The vehicle must be operated in accordance with North Carolina Motor Vehicle laws and any rules and regulations of the Association.
    - 5) The vehicle must be designed not to exceed a speed of 25 miles per hour.
    - 6) All persons in the vehicle must be seated in a place designed as a passenger seat while the vehicle is underway.
    - 7) Every vehicle must have a current annual permit issued by the Association. A permit shall be issued only in the name of a member of the Association and shall be affixed to the vehicle. The fee for an annual permit is \$25.00. The member to whom the permit is issued will be required to sign a permit application whereby the member certifies that the vehicle meets and will continue to meet the standards in these rules and regulations. The application also requires the applicant to assume responsibility of assuring that the operation of the vehicle is in accordance with these rules. The applicant will be required to release, indemnify, and hold harmless the Association from any liability arising out of the registration of permitting of the vehicle by the Association.
    - 8) The Association may fine permit holders or operators for violations of these rules. A permit may be revoked by the Island Administrator for a violation of these rules and regulations.
